TKT YL	TKT: Young Learners Tests your knowledge of the strategies and skills required to teach young learners - ideal if you're working in primary education.
TKT Module 1	TKT Module 1: Background to language teaching Tests your knowledge of the terms and concepts of English language teaching. It focuses on the factors underpinning the learning of English. Also, this module tests your knowledge of a range of materials, tasks and activities for English language teaching.
TKT Module 2	TKT Module 2: Planning for language teaching Focuses on the knowledge and skills you need to plan lessons. It also looks at assessment and resources that can guide your lesson planning.
TKT Module 3	TKT Module 3: Classroom management Tests your knowledge of what happens in the clasroom during language learning, and the teacher's role in classroom management.

You will be assessed throughout the course and there is no final examination. The two types of assessment are:

Module 1 - 3 and TKT YL	Paper-based test	Each module has one test paper, which lasts 80 minutes and has 80 questions. Each question is worth 1 mark. There are multiple-choice and matching questions.
